Nick handed me the reins some 12 years back and I'm proud to say it is the reason my hair has fallen out! I have huge support from the Trustees of the charity behind the BBB, Action Academy, and the people who work tirelessly all year round to make the BBB happen, together with the 50+ volunteers who do whatever they can to bring the BBB together.

2022 marked a milestone for the BBB - £1/4 million was raised!! Yes - since the first BBB over £250,000 has been raised by having this fabulous party each August! What an achievement!

So, I hear you ask, what has been done with this £1/4 million?

It's been spent supporting projects within Avon Tyrrell!

You see that lovely boathouse that has toilet and shower facilities, along with disabled access to the lake? Yeh, you helped with that.

The climbing tower? Yep, some of that too!

The 40+ bikes that the young people get use when they visit on residential trips? Yep, that was you! Oh, and the ongoing maintenance and the training of staff!

Accessible bikes and equipment so that the less abled can enjoy the area – Yep!

Honestly, the list goes on with the bits you have helped make possible. That is why the BBB Lime Green Army are so passionate. That is why the BBB Lime Green Army do it – each and every one of us. We all want to make a difference to a young person's life and, collectively, thanks the Nick's party in his garden back in 2007, that is why the BBB happens and we do make a difference.

I feel that we have yet to have the 'perfect' BBB. Each year we try to fine tune it to make it better. But what is better? What is perfection? If we find perfection will that be the end? We have had our dreams, desires and expectations hampered over the last few years by insurance, Covid and the like, but still hope that we can come up with a format that makes the BBB a special family weekend.

The BBB is a large event that requires work far in advance of the actual weekend. The following year's planning starts way in advance of the current event. Yep, we are already working on 2024 before 2023 has taken place! We start each year's build in early summer with a trail clearing camp – a weekend of heavy duty gardening! Not only does this help create the trails you'll race on, but it makes safe MTB trails for the visitors to Avon Tyrrell over the summer.

We move on to the site to start the BBB build on the Friday before you arrive and we spend that weekend doing more heavy duty gardening. We then move on to the main arena construction. Things like marquees, toilets, stages, electricity, sound, lights, barriers, hay bales, beer and stillage all start to arrive from Tuesday and the courses need to be signed and taped. I can't forget one of the most important jobs of the BBB – the bar! This was built by Richard (dad to me!) and run by our fabulous Landlady, Wendy! The final job is to erect the start arch and you'll find a relaxed smile on my face when it's up!

Behind the scenes, the Administration team work to produce the camp packs – that's a load of envelopes of stuff to stuff! In addition to running the raffle and generally helping to ensure that the event runs smoothly!

Then you all arrive! The chaos begins. And we start raising money for charity... Enjoy!



# Welcome to Avon Tyrrell Leaders in Outdoor Learning

For over 75 years, UK Youth has delivered inspiring outdoor learning at Avon Tyrrell, providing opportunities for children and young people to experience, learn and develop in an unrivalled environment.



We are open year-round and pride ourselves on being an accessible venue open to everyone, with tailored accommodation and activity programmes allowing groups and individuals to all benefit from outdoor learning.

#### Our history & Heritage

Our amazing house, built on the edge of the New Forest, has a remarkable history and some hidden stories to tell. In 1881 Lord John Manners was challenged to buy, train and ride the winner of the 1882 Grand National. Conditions on the day were one of the worst in race history but Lord Manners and Seaman (his horse) passed the winning post a short head in front of the race favourite, securing £28,000 in winnings. Lord Manners used his winnings to commission the building of Avon Tyrrell House.

Built in 1891, Avon Tyrrell House was a family home until World War I, when the Manners family opened Avon Tyrrell as a convalence centre for injured soldiers. In World War II the house was requisitioned as an intelligence gathering post and training area.

After use by the army in World War II, the Manners family decided to entrust the house and grounds to the 'Youth of the Nation' for use by children and young people to provide outdoor adventure. Avon Tyrrell was officially opened as an outdoor centre by Princess Elizabeth (now the late Queen Elizabeth II) in July 1949.



# BIG BIKE BASH CODE OF CONDUCT

During your participation in the Big Bike Bash at Avon Tyrrell Outdoor Centre, we kindly ask that you adhere to these rules for your own safety and the safety and enjoyment of others.

- NO WOOD FIRES! GAS BBQs and stoves ONLY. FIRE PITS are not permitted on site for this event.
- If you wish to use a GAS BBQ during your stay, please ensure that it is kept off the ground when in use, and is properly switched off after use.
- Please only consume food and drink purchased from our outlets in the 'Arena', at Cafe Explore or in the main house all profits go to the charity.
- Please help us by putting all your waste in the bins provided and tell us if a bin is full!
- Please respect other guests around you during your stay. Do not play loud music at any time and keep noise levels to a minimum at night.
- We have a quiet period from 11.30pm until 7:30 am.
- As we have large numbers of people on site; including small children, please only cycle on the designated tracks and always wear a helmet and please keep your speed down outside of the organised races.
- Parents/Guardians please accompany and supervise your children. Supervision is also suggested for those new to off-road riding.
- Please make sure your bike is in good working order, pay particular attention to the tyres, brakes and gears. There are retailers on site that can help here if you need it.
- Know your limitations. Off-road cycling can be fun and challenging but can be hazardous so don't try any stunts or tricks you can't do or have never tried before.

### - The pump & gravity track area is to be used only during races by inducted riders only.

- Please restrict vehicle movement on site, especially late at night, and keep vehicles off of grassy areas.
- Know where your nearest Fire Assembly point is in case of an emergency (see map).
- All rubbish/recycling should be disposed of inside the skips/bins provided. Please ensure nothing is left next to any of the skips/bins provided, as these can attract wildlife. A skip can be found at the entrance to the campsite, and an additional skip and recycling point can be found in the car park by reception. Please note: Guests leaving large quantities of rubbish will be charged for its removal.
- The main house is open for breakfast, but outside these opening times, access is restricted to house guests only.
- Damage to self catering lodges or Avon Tyrrell property will be invoiced to the named person responsible for the group or party without exception.
- Please ensure you abide by all out of bounds signs and do not enter areas of restricted access.
- Please ensure you are aware of all water hazards on site, and take any necessary precautions to ensure the safety of your group.

#### ALWAYS WEAR A HELMET WHEN CYCLING

As well as having direct access to the New Forest, Avon Tyrrell land also borders a number of private properties. If you are unsure of our boundaries please ask. Many are barbed wire - take care.

In fairness to our housekeeping staff, we kindly ask that you leave ample time to pack up and depart your lodge accommodation so that arriving groups can check in on time. Your departure time is 10am. Campers are welcome to stay pitched until Monday lunchtime.

Please also note that to comply with our insurance certification, self catering accommodation is sold with a maximum upper limit of occupants. Guests must ensure the maximum numbers are not exceeded.

**Please Use Common Sense** – If you are a nuisance to others and cannot abide by these rules, we will have no hesitation to ask individuals/groups to leave, no refund will be provided.

#### Thinking of doing lake activity sessions during the BBB?

Our instructor covering sessions on the lake is available to brief participants but here's some key points of extra information to take note of before you decide to proceed:

When participating in water sports there maybe some natural hazards you may come across like sharp stones or fishing hooks on the bottom of the lake, potential water-borne illnesses or risks such as drowning and hypothermia. However these are rare and with a bit of care and management certainly should not stop us from enjoying sessions. By following a few simple rules we can stay safe AND enjoy all that the great outdoors has to offer!

- If you have any unhealed cuts or grazes cover them up with micropore tape/waterproof plasters.
- Wear suitable shoes and clothes for the activity
- Avoid prolonged swimming in the lake or drinking lake water
- Once the safety equipment is on (like buoyancy aids), don't adjust or play with it, ask an instructor first
- Wash your hands, face and body after sessions there is a shower block next to the lake
- If after the session, even after a few days, you start to feel unwell perhaps with flu-like symptoms and are at all worried, see your GPmake sure you explain what you have been up to.

#### **Additional Information for Campers**

Please ensure you pitch your tents at least 6 metres away from neighbouring groups and lodges, and at least 3 metres from others within your own group.

Please be aware of the risks of Lymes Disease (from ticks) and Weils Disease (from water courses) which can occur in the New Forest. Reception can give advice on these if you have any concerns.

Should you experience any problems during your stay please report them immediately to our reception staff or BBB Volunteers in lime green.

Out of office hours please contact the On Call member of staff who can be contacted using the emergency phone point outside reception, or by calling 07743 559344.

Please note our rules are to ensure everyone's enjoyment, please abide by these and remember we are only able to help if we are aware of the problem.

Disclaimer: Our events and races are fun but can carry the risk of injury. Whilst we have insurance and risk assessment in place for all activities everyone must follow this Code. In participating in the Big Bike Bash you understand and agree that you do this entirely at your own risk, that you must rely on your own ability to deal with all hazards and that you must ride in a manner which is safe for yourself and all others. #### **XC CROSS COUNTY - THE BIG ONE!**

5k of windy single track and wider passages. Twisty sections and fast sections through grassland, pine forest gravel tracks and dirt tracks. It's a varied track and there are some challenging short climbs but it is not massively hilly.

#### **XC Night Race**

The above - only darker, like the otter.

#### **Balance Bike Race**

A race for the little ones on their balance bikes - no pedals allowed.

#### Wheelie Competition

Who can pull the most stylish wheelie! All ages welcome.

#### **Bike Limbo**

It's like normal limbo but on a bike. The bar gets lower and lower. To make it fairer this year we will be supplying the bikes

#### **Exploder Challenge**

Pump up the jam - err - inner tube. It's a race between two people and the clock to see who can explode an inner tube the fastest. There's an element of luck here if you find a more vulnerable tube than your opponents. Some are super tough. One tube was once inflated to the same size as the Large Hadron Collider.

#### **Track Stand Competition**

A supreme test of balance. You and normally about 30 others stand on your bikes and the last one to put their feet down is the winner. I think this year we will ban tricycles.

#### **Bunny Hop Challenge**

Put on your bunny ears (no really you should) and prepare to hop and make nibbling noises. You really should be on a bike as well for this. It's the reverse of the limbo - the bar gets higher and higher.

#### RACE TO THE VIBRANT FOREST

Strictly over 18s. It's a race around our short track. The rules change every year and it's a highlight.

#### **Eliminator**

It's a race on the obstacle filled, twisty rooty track in the trees just off the main arena. The last riders are picked off at each lap. Like Donkey Kong, there are barrels flying and seems that Mario has sprung a leak - water pistols encouraged for this event please spectators!

#### Short Track Night Race

Amazingly similar to the event above. Except this time we have hidden the sun on the other side of the earth which makes it more of a challenge.

#### Hill Climb

Ride up the slalom course - an eliminator race and against the clock. It's not as easy as it looks and some of the dads take it far too seriously and then look like they are going to collapse.

#### **Gravity Track Racing**

It's a race to be the fastest to the bottom with different classes down the gnarly track, which is genuinely scary, and it keeps the paramedics on their toes! You have to have had an induction for this race

#### **Foot Down**

Everyone starts in the little square and then cycles around and around very, very slowly until you put your foot down. Some people cheat by nudging opponents - it's only cheating if you get caught! Last one in is the winner.

#### Silly/Inappropriate Bike Race

A race on bikes that are inappropriate. There are no rules, only that it should not be right in any sense of the word.

Dual Slalom by Bournemouth Cycleworks
A slalom with two people racing to the bottom of the track.




